Health Innovation Bank (i-health bank)

As a starting point debate two kinds of health innovations are to be identified for inclusion in the i-health bank: (i) health policy innovations led by legitimate public authorities and (ii) product, service, process innovations, driven by community innovation stakeholders. Interested organization or individuals are welcome to submit innovation projects to the I-health Bank to be presented during the conference in the Innovation Health Fair until September 15, 2008. Registration is possible for satellite meetings, pre conference meetings and main conference activities or a combination of conferences.




Student Fees
