EECS degrees from MIT and a licenciatura in electrical engineering from IST. His interests are in algebraic and statistical signal/ image/video processing. His current research includes distributed decision in sensor networks, time reversal imaging, and bioimaging. He is the principal investigator for a large interdisciplinary multi-university project, SPIRAL (www.spiral.net), on automatic performance tuning of HW/SW implementations of signal processing algorithms.

He is the President Elect for the IEEE Signal Processing Society (SPS) (2006-07), one of the largest IEEE Societies, and serves on several IEEE Boards, on the Editorial Board of the IEEE Proceedings and of the ACM Transactions on Sensor Networks, he chaired the IEEE Transactions Committee that joins the 80+ Editors in Chief of IEEE Transactions, and he is on the steering committee of two major Conferences: the IEEE International Symposium on Biolmaging (ISBI) and the ACM/IEEE International Symposium on Information Processing and Sensor Networks (IPSN). He was the Editor in Chief for the IEEE Transactions on Signal Processing and interim Editor in Chief for the IEEE Signal Processing Letters. He is a Fellow of the IEEE, a Fellow of AAAS, and a corresponding member of the Academia das Ciências de Portugal.
