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# Objectives and headline target

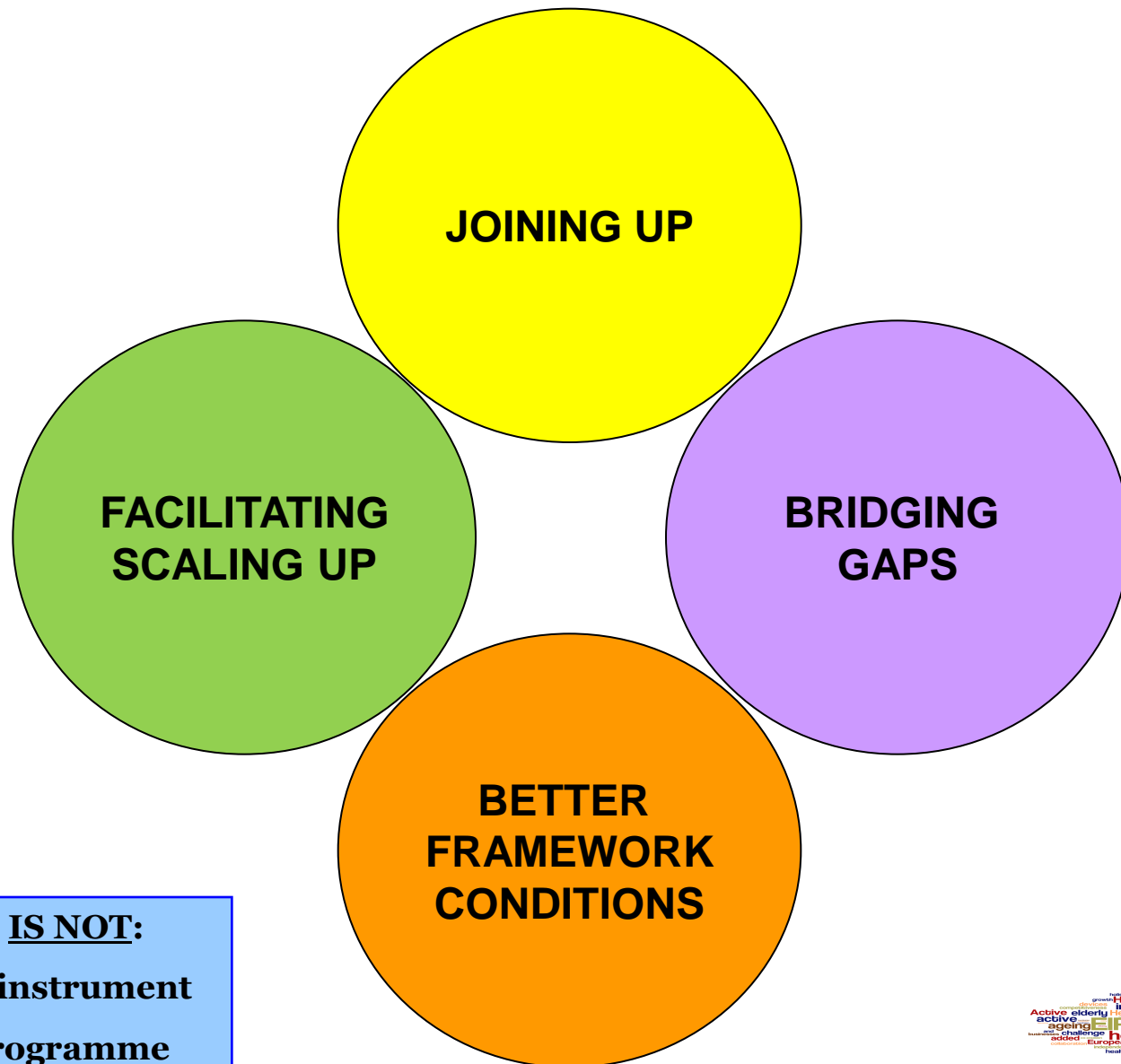
## A triple win for Europe

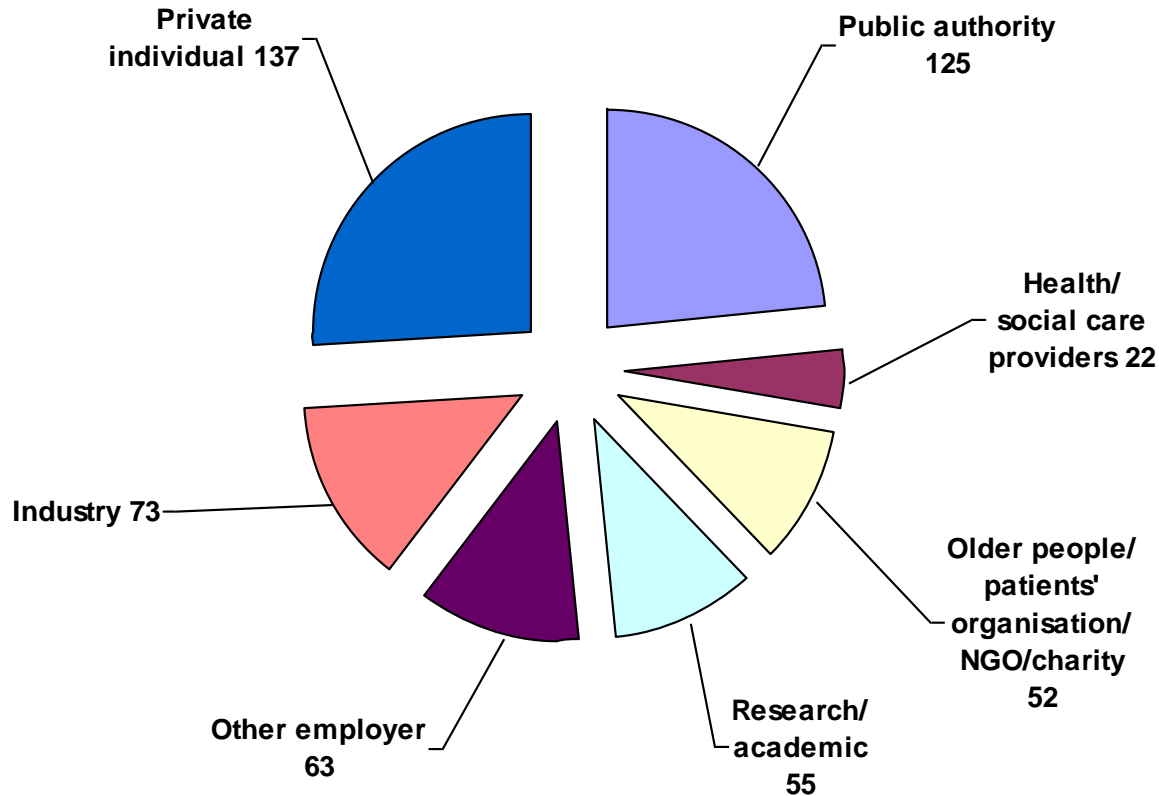
## What the EIP IS NOT:

Number of replies received per sector, total 524









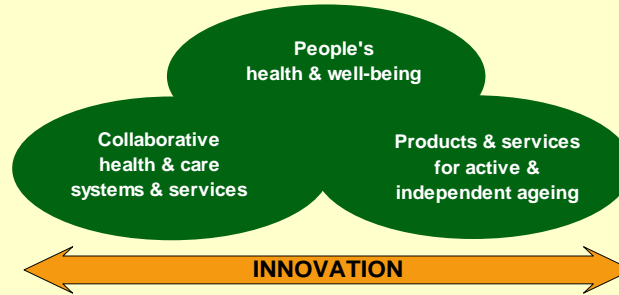

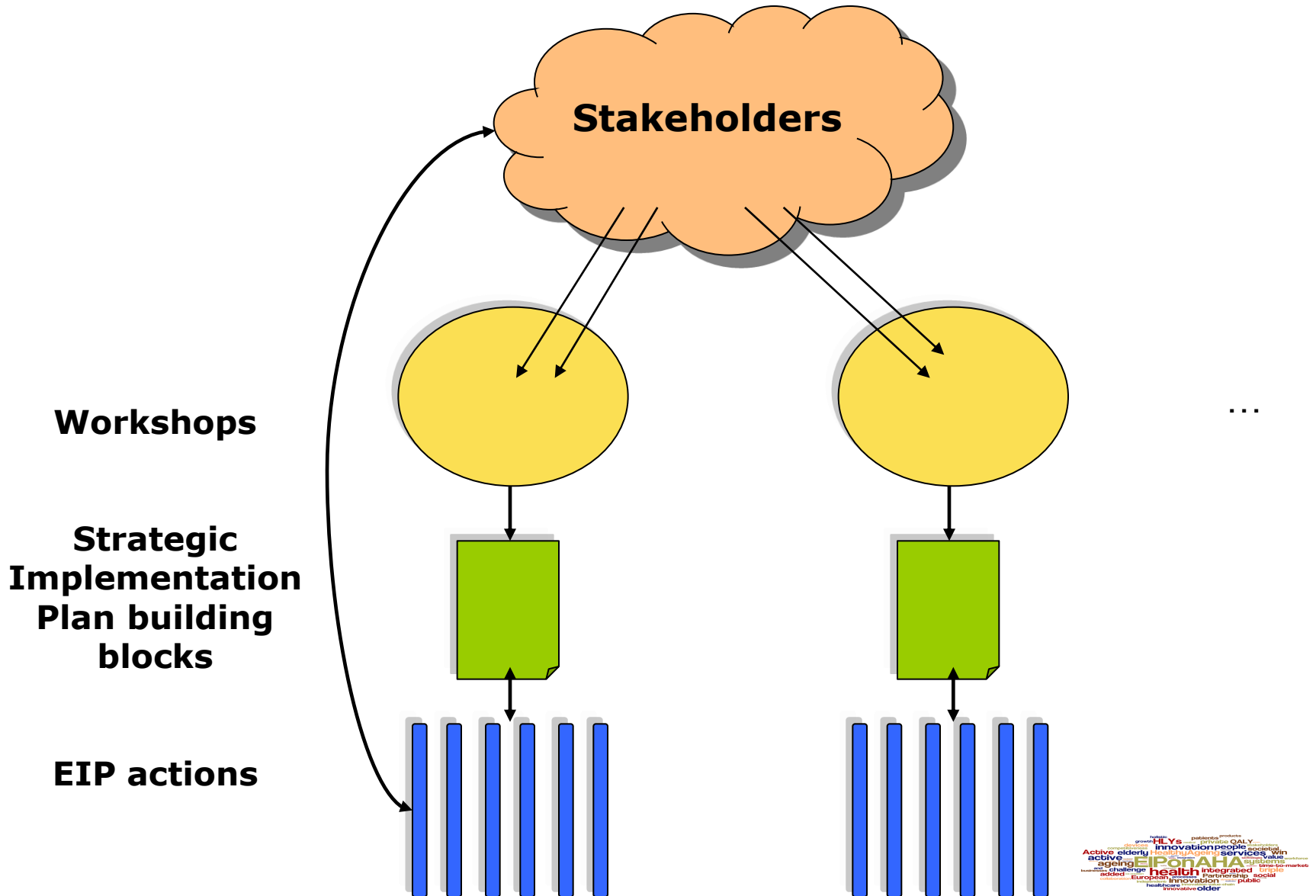
# EIP example: fall prevention

- 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of 65+ fall at least once per year, 1 in 8 hospital admissions, ...
- We have devices for balance monitoring, physical/cognitive training, personal medication advice, ...
- But: not enough fall prevention innovation reaches the elderly

## The EIP could address:

- **Common strategy** starting from today's practice
- **Financing gaps** by joining up public and private insurance providers and financiers
- **Aggregated evidence** to guide procurement
- **Interoperability** by partnering standardisers, industry and users
- **Multi-disciplinary research in fall prevention** by connecting researchers to citizens, carers and procurers
