Attached please find the first draft of the collaboration proposal that has been prepared by Tom Aretz and his dedicated team. This plan is the result of the short term assessment period outlined in the Memorandum of Understanding that we signed earlier this year. Included with this proposal is a list of items prepared by Tom that still need to be addressed within the Portuguese components of the collaboration. Our plan is to complete the open items and submit the final deliverable by the end of August.

Since we last spoke, there has been a change in the approval process at the University level. This is an extraordinary time for us here at Harvard – a new University President, Dr. Drew Gilpin Faust began her tenure on July 1, 2007 and a new Dean for Harvard Medical School, Dr. Jeffrey Flier will begin his tenure on September 4, 2007. As a result of these leadership transitions, it is necessary for us to determine whether this proposal will have the full endorsement of the University's new leadership and this review process is underway. As you are intimately involved in gaining the appropriate approvals in Portugal for this project, I am sure you understand the importance of full endorsement from the leadership to ensure the sustainable success of the project.
