William Cushley is Professor of Molecular Immunology at the University of Glasgow. In addition to his own research activity in immunobiology and a strong commitment to graduate education and training, he has served numerous bodies as a peer reviewer. He has served on UK research council grant awarding panels (for AFRC and BBSRC) and was a member of the Quality of Science panels that reviewed AFRC / BBSRC research institute performance using both bibliometric analysis and institute site visits. In recent years he has acted as Chair of European Science Foundation panels reviewing and awarding research grants in Italian universities and postdoctoral fellowships via the AXA programme. IN recent years he was a trustee of Medical Research Scotland (2006 - 2013), the largest grant-awarding charity in Scotland, and was Chair of the Board of Trustee Directors (2007-2013) of the Babraham Institute in Cambridge, a world-leading centre for research in epigenetics, signalling and immunology.
