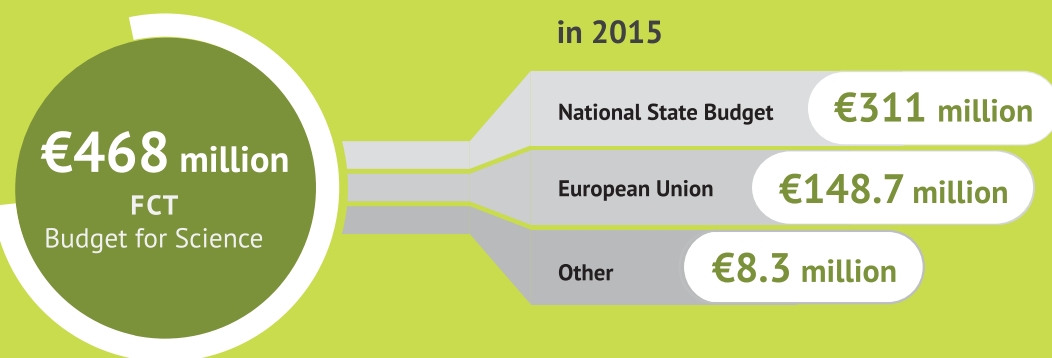


Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia (FCT) is the national funding agency for science and research in Portugal.
