

Anália Torres, PHD in sociology, is Full Professor of Sociology in ISCSP, School of Social and Political Sciences of the Technical University of Lisbon, Head of the Sociology Coordination Unit, researcher in CAPP (Centre for Administration & Public Policies). She is also associate researcher in CIES/IUL (Centre for Research and Studies in Sociology) in IUL (Lisbon University Institute).

She was President of ESA (European Sociological Association) from 2009 to 2011.

In ISCSP-UTL she is the Coordinator of the Sociology Unit. Apart from creating and teaching various courses in the field of sociology and research methodology, she created various masters and graduate courses in the field of sociology, family and gender.

In 2012, she created and coordinates CIEG (Interdisciplinary Centre for Gender Studies) in ISCSP (<http://cieg.wordpress.com>), which has researchers and collaborators at national level from various scientific backgrounds.

She has been directing for long and within national and international research network research teams on family, gender, marriage, divorce, work and family, poverty, drug addition, youth and child protection system.

Since 1995, she participates actively in several European research networks. She is in the research team responsible for the European Social Survey application in Portugal since its beginning in 2002. In the last years she integrated research teams on the scope of the Framework Programs 6 and 7 directing several work packages in the projects WORKCARE (2006-2009) and WORKCARE Synergies (2009-2011) (<http://trabalharecuidar.cies.iscte.pt/>).

With sixteen books published she is sole author of four, first author of six -two of them in English - and co-author of six. She is the author of more than fifty articles and chapters of books in several languages.

She was President of the Portuguese National Sociological Association (2002-2006), and served ESA (European Sociological Association) as member of the Executive Committee (2005-2009), Chair of Conference Committee and Vice-President (2007-2009) and President (2009-2011).
